



TERMS OF USE OF THE INDEED PROJECT KEY EXPLOITABLE RESULTS

The Terms of Use of INDEED project results based on the Grant and Consortium Agreements outline the guidelines and principles governing the ownership, access, and exploitation of INDEED project results. These agreements ensure that all involved parties have clear and fair terms for using and benefiting from the project's outcomes, fostering a cooperative environment for innovation and development.

For each result, main and other (minor) owners were defined. The first are considered to be those who contributed significantly to the development of a given result (conceptual work, software work, content creation, etc.). The latter group includes those partners who had an input in creating a given result, but their role or effort was significantly smaller, but important from the point of view of developing the result.
